



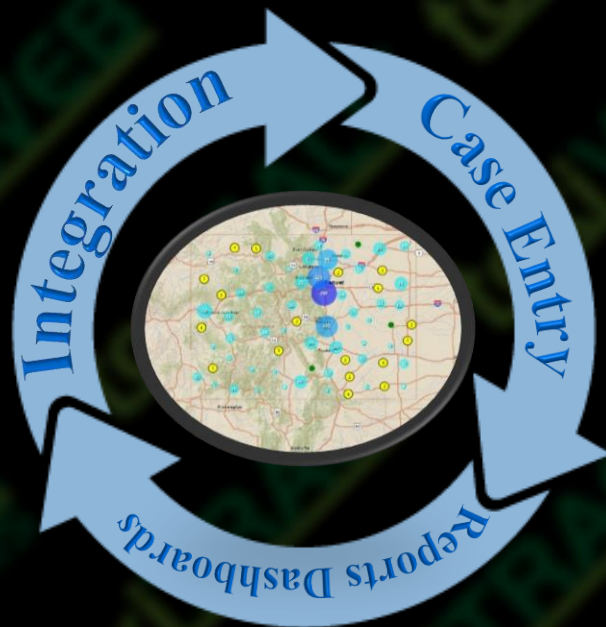

# What is Required for Next Steps?

- Request time to work with CAS Team
  - To ensure a solid feedback path, we will stage the implementation with poison centers based on needs and availability
- Setup a Testing Environment
  - toxiCALL® 4 and toxiCALL® 5 databases must be on same SQL Server Database
  - Identify needs and usage of archive databases
- Test Migration and usability
  - Ensure data migrated correctly
  - Identify data fields to be moved to proper fields (e.g. DOB, EMR)
  - Ensure the toxiCALL® 5 has the features you require for each phase
- Begin Phased Implementation
  - Schedule time with CAS Support to ensure all goes well

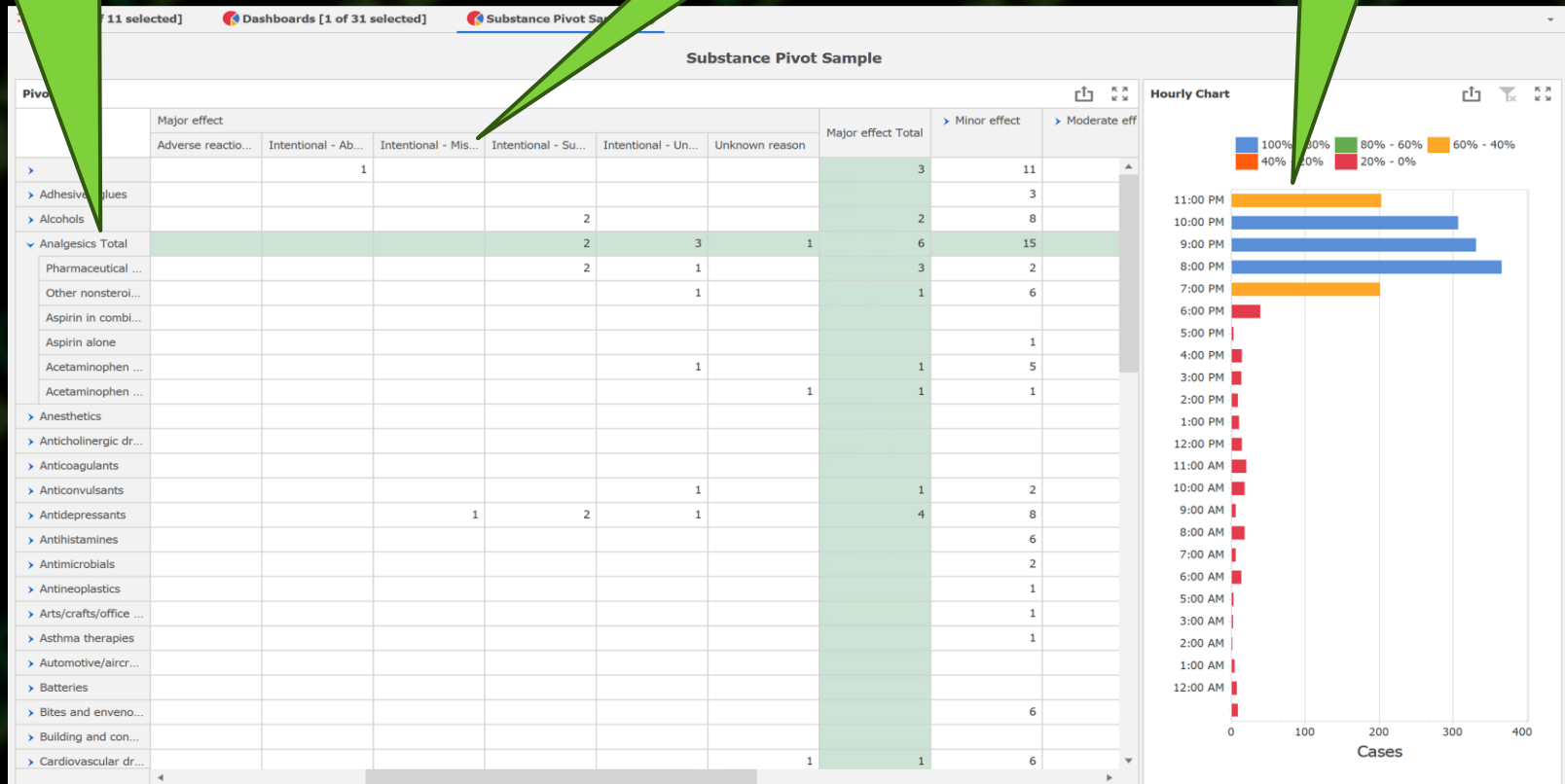

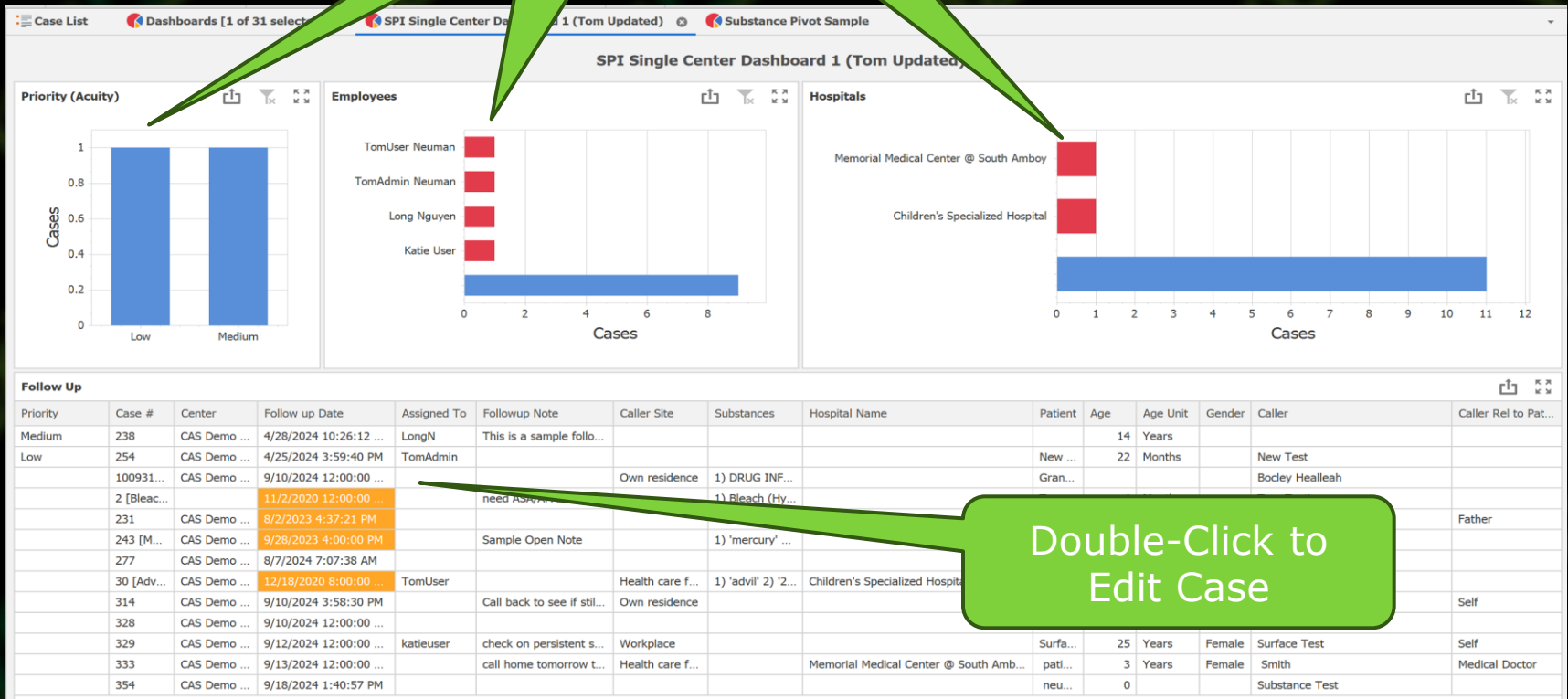

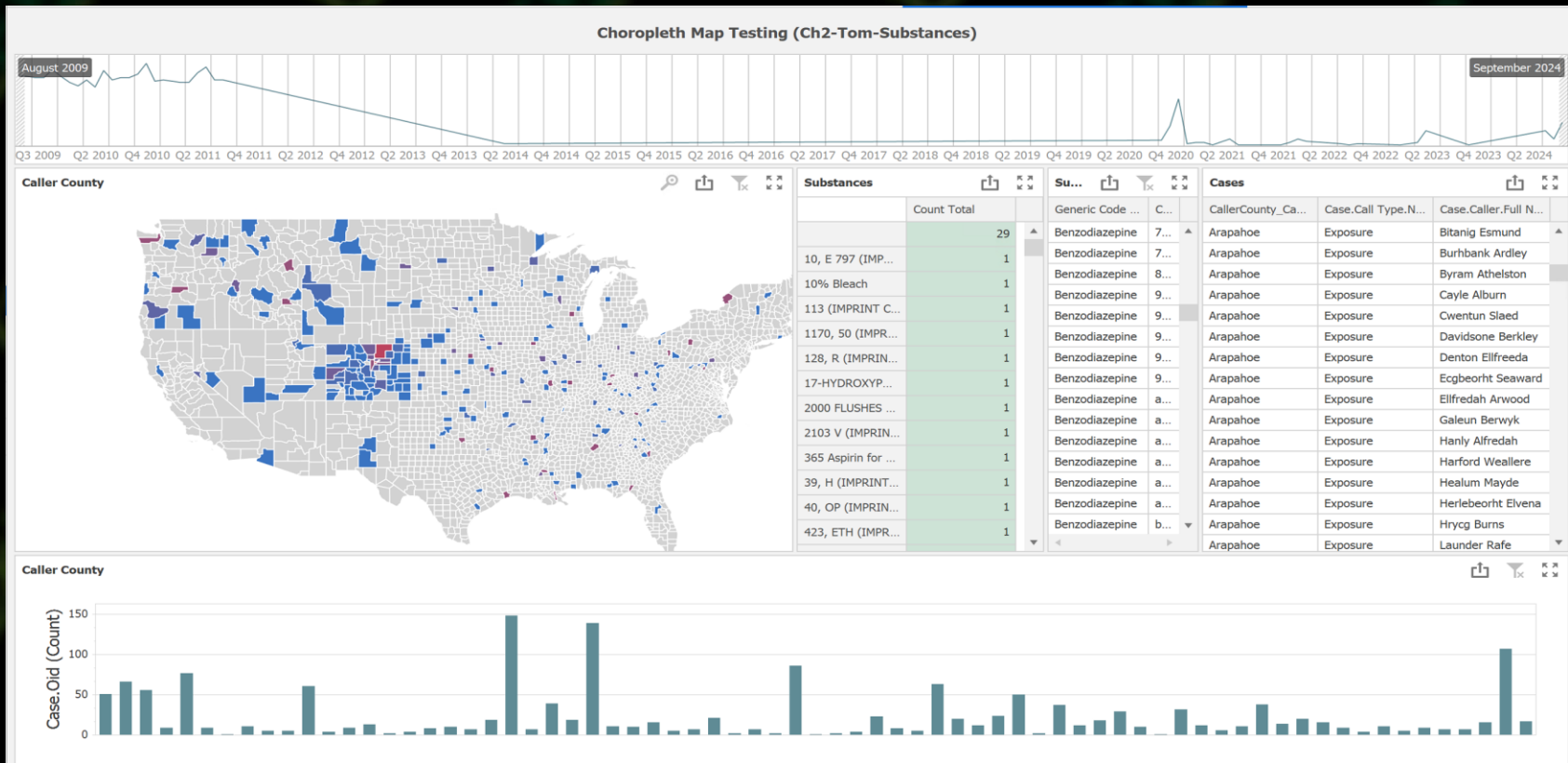

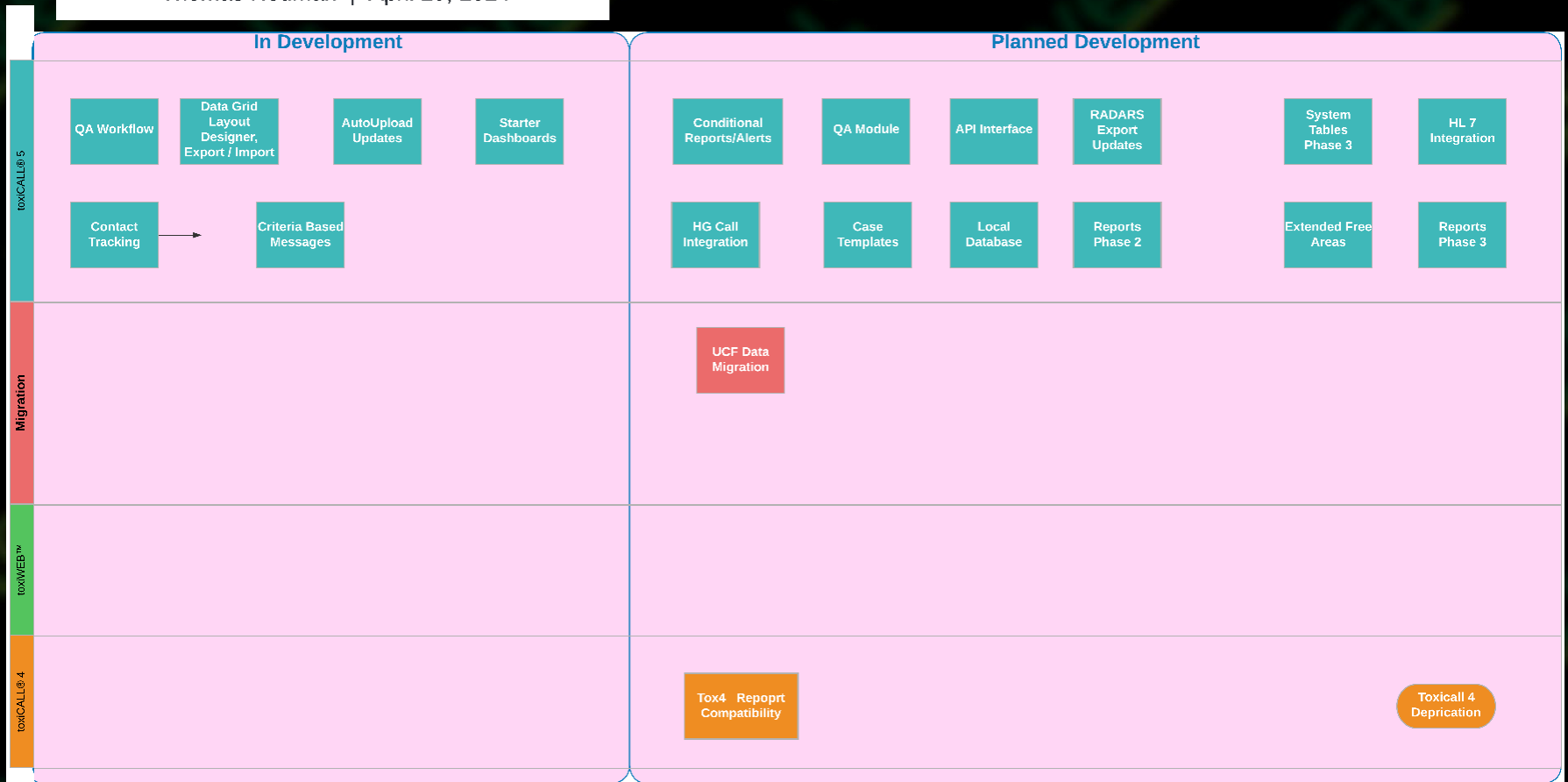
